THE "ONE ANOTHERS" PASSAGES

The phrase "one another" is derived from the Greek word allelon, which means "one another, each other; mutually, reciprocally." They are specific commands teaching us how (and how not) to relate to one another. Obedience to these commands is imperative. It forms the basis for all true Christian community and has a direct impact on our witness to the world (John 13:35).

- Love one another (Jo 13:34)
- Be devoted to one another (Rom 12:10)
- Honor one another above yourselves (Rom 12:10)
- Live in harmony with one another (Rom 12:16)
- Build up one another (Rom 14:19; 1 Thess 5:11)
- Be likeminded towards one another (Rom 15:5)
- Accept one another (Rom 15:7)
- Admonish one another (Rom 15:14; Col 3:16)
- Greet one another (Rom 16:16)
- Care for one another (1 Cor 12:25)
- Serve one another (Gal 5:13)
- Bear one another's burdens (Gal 6:2)
- Forgive one another (Eph 4:2, 32; Col 3:13)
- Be patient with one another (Eph 4:2; Col 3:13)
- Be kind and compassionate to one another (Eph 4:32)
- Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs (Eph 5:19)

- Submit to one another (Eph 5:21, 1 Pe 5:5)
- Consider others better than yourselves (Phil 2:3)
- Bear with one another (Col 3:13)
- Teach one another (Col 3:16)
- Comfort one another (1 Thess 4:18)
- Encourage one another (1 Thess 5:11)
- Exhort one another (Heb 3:13)
- Stir up [provoke, stimulate] one another to love and good works (Heb 10:24)
