THE "ONE ANOTHERS" PASSAGES

The phrase "one another" is derived from the Greek word *allelon*, which means "one another, each other; mutually, reciprocally." They are specific commands teaching us how (and how not) to relate to one another. Obedience to these commands is imperative. It forms the basis for all true Christian community and has a direct impact on our witness to the world (John 13:35).

POSITIVE COMMANDS

- **Love** one another (Jo 13:34)
- **Be devoted** to one another (Rom 12:10)
- **Honor** one another **above yourselves** (Rom 12:10)
- **Live in harmony with** one another (Rom 12:16)
- **Build up** one another (Rom 14:19; 1 Thess 5:11)
- **Be likeminded towards** one another (Rom 15:5)
- **Accept** one another (Rom 15:7)
- **Admonish** one another (Rom 15:14; Col 3:16)
- **Greet** one another (Rom 16:16)
- **Care for** one another (1 Cor 12:25)
- **Serve** one another (Gal 5:13)
- **Bear** one another's **burdens** (Gal 6:2)
- **Forgive** one another (Eph 4:2, 32; Col 3:13)
- **Be patient with** one another (Eph 4:2; Col 3:13)
- **Be kind and compassionate to** one another (Eph 4:32)
- **Speak** to one another **with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs** (Eph 5:19)
- **Submit** to one another (Eph 5:21, 1 Pe 5:5)
- **Consider** others **better than yourselves** (Phil 2:3)
- **Bear** with one another (Col 3:13)
- **Teach** one another (Col 3:16)
- **Comfort** one another (1 Thess 4:18)
- **Encourage** one another (1 Thess 5:11)
- **Exhort** one another (Heb 3:13)
- **Stir up [provoke, stimulate]** one another to **love and good works** (Heb 10:24)
- **Show hospitality** to one another (1 Pe 4:9)

NEGATIVE COMMANDS (HOW NOT TO TREAT ONE ANOTHER)
